Here's some new faith formation conversations. Your ideas may come from nature, talks with people in school or work, dreams, goals, worship, prayer life, Bible devotions or other books, a

still, small voice inside, a family trip, and various other ways. Pay attention to how God works! These ideas came from a Synod Epic workshop where we partnered up and picked one to share. In minutes we shared amazing stories one on one, surrounded by people who care about faith! Tell about a time when you were frightened or afraid. How was God involved? Tell about a time when you felt God very close to you...right there present with you.

Tell about a special time of prayer that you had with God.

Tell about a time you felt God was using a special talent of yours to help someone.

Tell about a time when you were really worried about someone or something. How did you feel God's presence?

Tell about a time of forgiveness or reconciliation. How was God involved?

TREASURER'S REPORT

The treasurer's report shows an account balance of \$60,863.48 as of August 31, 2020. Of that amount, \$42,967.14 is non-budget, and the budget has a balance of \$17,896.34.

Motion by Linda Evje, seconded by Joy Hartleben, to approve the Treasurer's Report and the bills as presented to be paid. Carried.

Peggy gave out 2021 Committee budget worksheets and would like preliminary reports by the October meeting.

PASTOR'S REPORT

- Finalized plans for upcoming baptism and funeral
- Continues to meet with church committees to help plan worship and education events and continues to meet with area church leaders to share ideas.
- Continues to provide pastoral support via home and hospital visits, phone calls, and other online portals. Brought monthly communion to Rainbow Apt. residents and other Redeemer members.
- Will attend virtual Synod Assembly on 9/26/20 and will be on vacation Oct. 1-8

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Parish Life

- Joy will begin Motion Tracking at council meetings to keep track of completion and progress made by council on motions made during meetings.
- Shared Thank You card received from Pastor Phil,
- Working on 2021 Guidelines and evaluations are coming up.

Parish Education No Report

Worship/Music/Arts

- Feedback on Services is encouraged and volunteers at services are needed.
- At their meeting, they discussed use of communion cards in the future and how more music could be incorporated during the service.
- October Services will offer communion every Sunday except the 1st Sunday, Oct. 4.
- October 25 is Reformation Sunday-Wear Red
- Christmas worship will be Christmas Eve at 4:00. None on Christmas Day.
- Discussed with Zion possible joint services in the future. Possibly Nov.15.
- Kicked around the idea of a caroling event and bonfire in December.

Trustees

- Some members of the furnace committee met on Sept. 1. It was decided we would try to get 2-3 furnace quotes.
- Brad met with PGA this week. They recommend 96% efficient furnaces. (We currently have 80%.) Some duct work will need to be done but not much. Brad will get quotes on 80% and 96% efficient units as well as quotes on cooling systems for the upper level of the church.
- Kevin Rosenow will contact Chad Popp and possibly the company that replaced the furnace at Zion.

OLD BUSINESS

- Furnace committee recommendations: See Trustee Report
- Redeemer and Zion Council met on August 25 to discuss the two-point parish requirements given to us by the synod office.
- Constitution committee has been making headway on updating our constitution to align with the required synod model. When complete a special congregational meeting will be held to present it.

NEW BUSINESS

 A motion was made by Peggy Emmel, seconded by Maribeth Netzler, to move the Larson Fund out of the Income Fund and to an American Balance Fund in order to separate it from the Christian Education Fund. Motion carried.

Next Council meeting, Thursday, October 8 at 5:00pm.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

Motion made by Linda Evja, seconded by Lois Anderson, to adjourn. Carried.

There will be a special congregational meeting October 18th at 9:30 a.m. to approve the purchase and installation of new furnaces for the sanctuary. We currently have two bids and a recommendation will be made by the

committee and presented to the council at the October 8th meeting.

Our constitution and by-laws (1990) are being updated and will be available for your review by October 11th. Much of the work has already been done for us by following the Model Constitution for Congregations of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (2019). This update is necessary for us to proceed in forming a two point parish with Zion Lutheran Church, Tigerton.

Our current constitution is very similar in content, except the Model Constitution uses very legalistic language. Information on the update will be presented on Sundays in October and November. Any additions/changes to the "new constitution" must be made prior to the special meeting November 15th at 9:30 a.m. At the special meeting the "new constitution" will be approved (without change) by a majority vote and ratified without further change at the annual meeting (January) by a two-thirds vote. This procedure is in accordance with our current constitution.


